

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PACIFIC FAIRGROUNDS CARNIVAL (THE EVENT)

FRI 18 SEP – SUN 4 OCT 2020

1. These Terms and Conditions apply to all promotions conducted by Pacific Fair Shopping Centre. By participating in the Event, Participants accept these Terms and Conditions. These Terms and Conditions may be amended or replaced from time to time; entrants should check the promotion page on the Pacific Fair Shopping Centre website.
2. All attendees at and participants in, The Event, must observe the following conditions and acknowledge that:
 - a. All persons enter at their own risk;
 - b. Bookings are essential for COVID-19 tracking and to prevent crowding at entry points.
 - c. This event is operating in compliance with a COVID Safe Event Plan. Follow the rules and keep us all safe. Practice social distancing. Wash your hands regularly. Be prepared to leave your contact details for tracing purposes.
 - d. Stay at home if you are unwell or have a cough, fever, sore throat, fatigue or shortness of breath, have travelled from overseas or a COVID-19 hotspot within the last 14 days or have been in close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19.
 - e. Must use hand sanitiser before entry.
 - f. Please adhere to physical distancing floor decals when lining up for your timeslot.
 - g. Maintaining physical distancing requirements is the individual's responsibility.
 - h. We have the right to refuse service and insist the anyone with these symptoms leaves the venue.
 - i. If you become unwell during the event, please seek assistance from event staff.
 - j. All customers must always listen and obey ride operators. Customers disobeying instructions will be asked to leave the ride.
 - k. Please book only once to allow as many Pacific Fair customers to experiences this free activation. Multiple day bookings may be cancelled and notified.
 - l. Children under 5 years of age must always be accompanied by an adult;
 - m. Parent/ guardians are responsible for the safety of children within their care and must always actively supervise any children within their care and acknowledge that the staff of the Operator cannot supervise persons (including children) who are under the supervision on others.
 - n. Train Ride –
 - i. Customers participate at their own risk.
 - ii. Customers under 95cm tall must be accompanied by an adult 16+ years of age
 - iii. Customers must always occupy a seat and remain seated whilst the ride is in motion.
 - iv. No portion of limbs to protrude outside carriage.
 - v. Locking/unlocking of doors to only to be performed by operator.
 - vi. Customers must always obey operators' instructions.

- o. Teacup Ride –
 - a. Customers participate at their own risk.
 - b. Riders must be 100cms in height to ride alone.
 - c. Children under 100cm in height may ride when accompanied by an adult 16+ years of age.
 - d. Unfortunately, no ‘babes in arms’.
 - e. Children must always remain seated while the ride is in motion.
 - f. Maximum one adult and two children, or four children per Cup.
 - g. Wait for the ride operator to invite you onto the ride. This will only happen when the ride is completely clear of patrons and ready for the next group.
 - h. You must always listen and obey ride operator instructions.
 - i. No food or drinks. No smoking. Permitted on the ride.
 - j. No offensive or abusive language.
 - k. Be courteous and respectful.
 - l. Patrons must obey the instructions and directions of the ride operator while on the ride.
 - m. Patrons disobeying the instructions of the ride operator and/or posted signs will be asked to leave the ride.
 - n. The ride operator will enforce the above rules for your safety and enjoyment.
 - o. Please feel free to consult the ride operator if you have any questions or problems.
 - p. By entering the course, you acknowledge that you have read and accept the terms and conditions.
- p. Lucky Duck Prizes
 - i. Prizes allocated as per numbers on duck. Prizes subject to change due subject of prize availability.
- q. No pushing;
- r. No running;
- s. No food, no drinks, no smoking used whilst in use;
- t. No offensive or abusive language will be tolerated;
- u. Please be courteous and respectful of all patrons and staff;
- v. Participants must obey the instructions and directions of event staff;
- w. Participants disobeying the instructions/directions of event staff and/or Event signage will be asked to leave;
- x. Event staff will enforce the above rules for the safety and enjoyment of all attendees and participants
- y. Pacific Fair Shopping Centre reserve the right to refuse entry or remove any person from the Event conduct including vandalism, stealing, offensive behaviour, queue line jumping, failure to properly supervise persons under their care, failure to follow instructions or failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions generally.
- z. Participants must not be under the influence of illicit substances or alcohol. Participants who are believed to be under the influence of illicit substances or alcohol will be removed from the Event Operator.
- aa. Participants with medical conditions are responsible for assessing whether they can participate in the Event.
